

HOW TO GET YOUR MMJ CARD

GETTING TREATMENT, STEP BY STEP

01 DO YOU QUALIFY?

If you're a permanent or seasonal Florida resident, and a physician has diagnosed you with a qualifying condition, including chronic pain, PTSD, cancer, crohn's disease, or epilepsy among others, you qualify.

DID YOU KNOW? If you live in Florida for 31 consecutive days or more you qualify as a seasonal resident.

02 FIND A PHYSICIAN

Visit [GETFLUENT.COM/PATIENTS](https://www.getfluent.com/patients) for a complete list of qualified physicians in your area and their contact information. Schedule a consultation with the physician of your choice.

03 GO TO YOUR CONSULTATION

You and your physician will discuss your medical history and treatment options, including dosages and routes of consumption. Your physician will then write your recommendation, enter your information into the Florida Marijuana Use Registry, and provide you with your patient ID number. You'll use this to apply for your MMJ ID card. Be sure to provide your email address to receive important updates.

REMEMBER to bring a valid state ID and up to date medical records to your appointment.

04 APPLY ONLINE OR VIA MAIL

Complete the online application after receiving your patient ID number and physician recommendation. The current application processing fee is \$75 and online payments take approximately five business days to process.

05 FILL YOUR ORDER
